DECATUR, AL – Yesterday in Morgan County Gregory Ray Steenson, 47, of Decatur was arrested on warrants by which he is charged with eight (8) counts of Theft in the First Degree, Class B felonies; two (2) counts of Forgery in the Second Degree, Class C felonies; and one (1) count of Theft in the Second Degree, also a Class C felony. All of these charges involve transactions that occurred during Steenson's association with Priceville Partners, LLC., a local car lot and title loan business that is now in bankruptcy. It is alleged in the affidavits filed to support these arrest warrants that Steenson sold vehicles to various victims for which he did not have legal title and that he forged other individuals' names to documents requesting replacement titles for vehicles sold by him. Steenson's bond was set in the amount of \$285,000.00. As a condition of his bond, the court ordered Steenson to obtain permission of the court before transacting any business involving any vehicle.

The investigation into these allegations is being conducted by the Morgan County District Attorney's Office.

District Attorney Scott Anderson said, "This is an ongoing investigation and it is possible that additional arrests may be made in relation to these and other transactions."
