The Morgan County Courthouse is closed to the public due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The PTIP Staff is in the office, Monday through Friday, 8:30AM to 4:30PM (closed 12:00-1:00PM for lunch). May Monitoring has been re-set [from May 1st, 4th & 5th] to **MAY 4TH, 5TH & 6TH, 2020**. The Morgan County Courthouse will be closed Monday, April 27, 2020 and Monday, May 25, 2020, in observance of State holidays.

Continue to call color code! Drug screening is still in progress. If your color is called and you, routinely, report to the Courthouse for screenings, you MUST contact the PTIP Office for further instructions.

PTIP Monthly Payments (Administration Fee or Monitoring Fee) can be made electronically through nCourt at www.morgancountydapay.com. You must provide your case number. You can mail a Money Order or Cashier's Check to PTIP, Morgan County DA's Office, P.O. Box 1727, Decatur, AL 35602. Make payable to "PTIP." Please retain your receipt. No personal checks. Do not mail cash. Print your name and case number, clearly, on the Money Order or Cashier's Check.

Restitution/Court Costs Monthly Payments (4th Floor, Circuit Clerk's Office): You must mail a Money Order or Cashier's Check to ATTN: Circuit Clerk's Office, Morgan County Courthouse, 4th Floor, P.O. Box 668, Decatur, AL 35602. Make payable to the "Circuit Clerk's Office." Please retain your receipt. No personal checks. Do not mail cash. Print your name and case number, clearly, on the Money Order/Cashier's Check and on the outside of the envelope. To pay with a credit/debit card, you must appear in person and show identification. The balance must be paid in full when using a credit/debit card.
